OBJECTIVE

This one-day course extends the delegate's understanding gained by obtaining the CCNSG National Safety Passport for site working.

It helps supervisory staff who have responsibility for teams, but who may have had little or no training in their H&S responsibilities, or indeed, little training in the essentials of leadership.

The course is designed to provide an essential introduction to managing small teams within the context of health and safety in the engineering construction industry.

To attend this course delegates must hold a valid ECITB CCNSG Safety Passport. If a delegate does not have this, they will need to attend a CCNSG National 2 Day Safety Passport course first. The CCNSG LaTS card is valid for 3 years.

WHO SHOULD ATTEND?

Supervisory staff who have responsibility for teams.

Areas Covered:

- How to communicate safely
- How to lead a team successfully
- How to achieve safe outcomes
- Self-management
- How to work safely with others

HOW IS THE COURSE ASSESSED?

Each module of the ECITB CCNSG 1 Day LaTS is assessed through multiple choice question papers consisting of 20 questions each. The examination pass mark for each paper is set at 80%.

CERTIFICATION

On successful completion of the course delegates will receive an ECITB CCNSG LaTS card which must be shown alongside their ECITB CCNSG Safety Passport card.

This course meets the statutory requirements of the Health & Safety Executive.
