

NEBOSH National Certificate in Construction, Health & Safety Level 3

Course Details

The NEBOSH National Construction Certificate is a qualification both for those with construction management responsibilities and for those who are required to provide routine, day-to-day advice on health, safety and welfare in construction work.

The programme of study broadly mirrors that of the National General Certificate. However, due to the specific nature of the award, the opportunity arises to cover key construction issues in rather more technical detail than would be appropriate for a general health and safety award.

The National Construction Certificate therefore contains additional units and requires a slightly longer programme of study than its counterpart. It is thus designed to cover general health and safety issues within a construction context as well as placing emphasis on the specific construction issues that make the industry amongst the most dangerous in which to work.

The syllabus comprises 19 units:

- 1 Foundations in construction health and safety.
- 2 Policy.
- 3 Organising for health and safety in construction
- 4 Promoting a positive health and safety culture.
- 5 Risk assessment.
- 6 Principles of control.
- 7 General site issues – hazards and control.
- 8 Working at height – hazards and control.
- 9 Excavation work and confined spaces – hazards and control.
- 10 Demolition hazards and control.
- 11 Movement of people and vehicles – hazards and control.
- 12 Work equipment hazards and control.
- 13 Manual mechanical handling hazards and control.
- 14 Electrical hazards and control.
- 15 Fire hazards and control.
- 16 Chemical and biological health hazards and control.
- 17 Physical and psychological health hazards and control.
- 18 Incident investigation, recording and reporting.
- 19 Monitoring, review and audit.

ACourse for

Those with construction management responsibilities and for those who are required to provide routine day-to-day advice on health, safety and welfare in construction work.

Entry Requirements

No formal entry requirements are necessary.

Assessment

NEBOSH external examination to include:

- 1 Practical assessment and written report (2 hours).
- 2 The management of safety and health in construction work (2 hours).
- 3 Controlling construction workplace hazards (2 hours).

Learning Outcome

This course prepares students for the examination of The National Examination Board in Occupational Safety & Health (NEBOSH).

Progression after Programme

- Either the National General Certificate in Occupational Safety & Health (also available at Redcar & Cleveland College).
- Or the National Diploma of Occupational Safety & Health.

Students should be fully conversant with:

Material covered in the Health & Safety Executive booklets Essentials of Health & Safety at Work, and Human Factors in Industrial Safety, both published by HMSO; Principles of Health and Safety at Work - IOSH Publication.

The main items of legislation, as outlined in the new syllabus, that apply generally to workplaces. (New legislation will not be examinable until six months notice has been given. Notices will be made in the Board's Certificate Bulletin and also in the IOSH journal The Safety and Health Practitioner.)

NEBOSH - The National Examination Board in Occupational Safety and Health is an independent examining body which was founded in 1979, and has established itself as the authoritative national examining body in occupational safety and health. The current system of vocational qualifications has been developed to meet the safety and health training needs of industry, commerce, and public services in the 1990s.
