

NEBOSH National Certificate in Fire Safety and Risk Management Level 3

Course Details

The NEBOSH National Fire Safety and Risk Management Certificate provides an appropriate breadth of underpinning knowledge for non-specialists in fire safety to enable them to discharge more effectively their organisational duties or functions with respect to workplace fire safety.

The syllabus is divided into 3 units and 15 elements in total:

- Unit NGC1 Management of Health and Safety
- Unit FC1 Fire Safety and Risk Management
- Unit FC2 Practical Fire Risk Assessment

Managers, supervisors, employee representatives and others it aims to equip holders to contribute to the conduct and review of fire risk assessments and fire preventive and protective measures within most workplaces.

Entry Requirements

There are no barriers to entry to a NEBOSH National Fire Safety and Risk Management Certificate programme but it should be noted that the assessment includes a requirement to write a short report.

Assessment

Each unit of the NEBOSH National Fire Safety and Risk Management Certificate is assessed separately. Unit NGC1 and FC1 are assessed by a written examination. Unit FC2 is assessed by a practical fire risk assessment of a workplace. Candidates must achieve a pass standard in each unit to be awarded the NEBOSH National Fire Safety and Risk Management Certificate.

Learning Outcome

This course prepares students for the examination of The National Examination Board in Occupational Safety & Health (NEBOSH).
