

NEBOSH National Diploma in Occupational Health and Safety Level 6

Awarding Body NEBOSH

Course Details

The NEBOSH National Diploma in Occupational Health and Safety is accredited at Level 6 within the National Qualification Framework (NQF) by the Office of the Qualifications and Examinations Regulator (Ofqual) in England, the Department for Children, Education, Lifelong Learning and Skills (DCELLS) in Wales and the Council for Curriculum, Examinations and Assessment (CCEA) in Northern Ireland.

The NEBOSH National Diploma is the flagship NEBOSH award and is developed specifically for health and safety professionals.

This course runs over 2 years with 4 hours teaching per week. There are four modules:

- Module A: Management of Health and Safety
- Module B: Agents in the Workplace
- Module C: Workplace & Workplace Equipment
- Module D: Workplace based assignment.

Is this qualification recognised?

The qualification meets the academic requirements to apply for Graduate Membership (Grad IOSH) of the Institution of Occupational Safety and Health (IOSH). This is the first step to becoming a Chartered Health and Safety Practitioner as a Chartered Member of IOSH (CMIOSH). It is also accepted by the International Institute of Risk and Safety Management (IIRSM) as meeting the academic requirements for full membership (MIIRSM).

Holders of the NEBOSH National Diploma in Occupational Health and Safety may use the designatory letters "Dip NEBOSH" after their name and are invited to the annual NEBOSH Graduation and Awards Ceremony in the year following the successful completion of their award.

A Course for

The NEBOSH National Diploma is the qualification for aspiring health and safety professionals, building directly upon the foundation of knowledge provided by the NEBOSH National General Certificate. It is designed to provide students with the expertise required to undertake a career as a safety and health practitioner and also provides a sound basis for progression to postgraduate study.

Entry Requirements

NEBOSH General Certificate, Evidence of VQ Level 3 Health and Safety qualifications or Health and Safety Management experience.

Assessment

Each module is assessed by a 3 hour exam and there is also a workplace based assignment for the whole course of approximately 8000 words. There are also formative assignments for each module.

Learning Outcome

This course prepares students for the examination of The National Examination Board in Occupational Safety & Health (NEBOSH).

Progression after Programme

The National Diploma provides a sound basis for progression to MSc level: A number of UK universities offer MSc programmes that accept the National Diploma as a full or partial entry requirement. Persons completing the course are eligible to apply for Corporate Membership of the Institution of Occupational Health and Safety.
