Course Details

The Gold Standard is a national framework for continuous professional development setting out the skills and qualifications required for world class performance in key job roles in the process industries.

Cogent has worked closely with partners to create SHE qualifications which will meet the Gold Standard compliance competencies needed for a Process Operator and Process Technician. The course will be by flexible learning and requires home study and computer access.

To complete the Gold Standard Award the candidate is required to study the following:

Assessment

Each unit of the Cogent Gold Standard Safety is assessed separately. Unit 1 and 3 are assessed by a multi choice examination. Unit 2 is assessed by a practical risk assessment of the candidate's workplace. Unit 4 is assessed by an environmental impact assessment of the candidate's workplace.

Candidates must achieve a pass standard in each unit to be awarded the NEBOSH Award in Safety, Health and Environment for the Process Industries.
