COURSE DETAILS

The Degree level NEBOSH National Diploma is the flagship NEBOSH award and was the first UK vocational qualification to be developed specifically for health and safety professionals. Since its introduction in 1988 it has become established as the most popular qualification of its kind, with over 10,000 students having successfully gained the Diploma.

The qualification meets the academic requirements to apply for Graduate Membership (GRAD IOSH) of Institution of Occupational Safety and Health (IOSH).

This is the first step to becoming a Chartered Health and Safety Practitioner as a Chartered Member of IOSH (CMIOSH). It is also accepted by the International Institute of Risk and Safety Management (IIRSM) as meeting the academic requirements for full membership (MIIRSM).

Holders of the NEBOSH National Diploma in Occupational Health and Safety may use the designatory letters "DipNEBOSH" after their name and are invited to the annual NEBOSH Graduation and Awards Ceremony in the year following the successful completion of their award.

This course is delivered over two years, one afternoon per week for 30 weeks per year, by our dedicated team from the Redcar and Cleveland College Health and Safety Academy.

WHO SHOULD ATTEND?

The NEBOSH National Diploma is the qualification for aspiring Health and Safety professionals, building directly upon the foundation of knowledge provided by the NEBOSH National General Certificate. It is designed to provide students with the expertise required to undertake a career as a Health and Safety practitioner and also provides a sound basis for progression to postgraduate study.
