OBJECTIVE

The NEBOSH General Certificate in Occupational Health and Safety training course is a widely recognised qualification for general health and safety responsibilities.

The NEBOSH National General Certificate is broken down into the following units:

- Unit NG1 Management of Health and Safety
- Unit NG2 Controlling Workplace Hazards

WHO SHOULD ATTEND

There are no entry requirements for this qualification, however it is important that learners have a suitable standard of English language in order to understand and articulate the concepts contained in the syllabus.

This qualification is designed for anyone (managers, supervisors and workers) in any type of organisation.

It's ideal for anyone who needs a broad understanding of health and safety issues to be able to manage day-to-day risks effectively. Many people take the National General Certificate in Occupational Health and Safety (NGC) as a first step in a career in health and safety. It gives a valuable overview, and is a sound basis for further professional study.

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NATIONAL GENERAL CERTIFICATE EXAMINATION

At the end of the course, each delegate is required to sit an open book exam (NG1) and submit a written practical risk assessment (NG2).

WHAT IS AN OPEN BOOK EXAM?

An open book examination (OBE) enables you to sit your NEBOSH assessment on your own, usually in your own home or another safe and suitable location where you can concentrate.

You can expect to see questions that ask what? Could? How? Why? And where? These will not only assess what you know but what you can do with that knowledge; our examiners will be looking for you to demonstrate analytical, evaluation and creative skills as well as critical thinking.

Whatever format the question, it will relate to the syllabus and learning outcomes of your qualification.

To help you during the open book examination you can use resources such as notes, textbooks, learning materials and online resources.
