

# FOR APPRENTICES

## Maintenance Operations Apprenticeship Level 2

### Course Details

This Apprenticeship will support you further develop your career in a range of vocations within a maintenance operations environment assisting tradespeople with their practical activities. You will need to be with an employer within the maintenance operations environment.

You will collect evidence from your work activities and produce a portfolio to demonstrate that you have gained the required skills. In addition, you will complete a Level 2 Technical Certificate in Maintenance Operations at College one day a week for the duration of your framework.

### Apprenticeship Framework Components

- Level 2 NVQ Diploma in Maintenance Operations
- Level 2 Technical Certificate in Maintenance Operations
- Functional Skills

### Programme Content

The framework consists of a range of occupational units within the maintenance operations field and includes:

- General workplace safety
- Efficient working practices
- Erecting and dismantling access and working platforms
- Customer service within the construction industry
- Moving and handling resources
- Effective site handover

In addition, you will select from a range of optional units:

- Maintenance in carpentry and joinery
- Maintenance in painting and decorating
- Maintenance in plumbing
- Maintenance in tiling
- Maintenance in plastering
- Maintenance in trowel operations

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## Technical Certificate

The Technical Certificate is a separate qualification which assesses the specialist knowledge required within a particular job and will be completed at College one day a week. The Technical Certificate will be by an end exam and the completion of a synoptic practical task in the College workshops under work simulated conditions.

## Functional Skills

Functional Skills are skills that are needed in a range of activities in education and training, work and life in general. For this Framework you will be required to achieve Functional Skills.

The Functional Skills required for this framework are:

- Maths Level 1
- English Level 1

Successful completion of these functional skills is essential to complete the framework. Not all apprentices need to study their Functional Skills depending on previously gained qualifications. Further advice will be provided at enrolment.

## Duration

The average expected completion time for this framework is 14 months although it can take longer. The duration of your framework will be confirmed at enrolment.

## Earnings

## Holidays

Holidays will be agreed with your employer. Your minimum entitlement is 20 days per year plus Bank Holidays.

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## **Progression**

The majority of our apprentices continue to be employed on a full time basis at the end of the apprenticeship. There are good opportunities for self-employment or progression to an Advanced Apprenticeship at level 3.

## **Off The Job Training**

There is a requirement for all apprentices to complete 20% of their time in 'off the job' training. This includes the need to attend Redcar & Cleveland College at least one day a week.

## **Future Changes**

As part of the Apprenticeship Reform, this framework may be changing to a Standard.
