VTCT Level 1 Certificate in Hair and Beauty Skills

Why Hair and Beauty?

The VTCT Level 1 Award/Diploma in Hair and Beauty Skills is a qualification that has been designed to introduce you to a range of practical skills from across the Hair and Beauty Industry.

Entry Requirements

A formal interview and initial assessment is required before acceptance, to ensure the course is suitable.

What I will learn?

- Presenting a professional image in the salon
- Working with others in the hair and beauty sector
- Styling women's hair
- Shampoo and conditioning
- Temporary hair colour
- Plaiting and twisting
- Hand care
- Nail art application
- Basic manicure techniques
- Skin care
- Themed face painting
- Health and safety in the salon

You will begin on the Level 1 Award for 6 weeks and upon successful completion you will progress onto the Level 1 Diploma for the rest of the academic year.

This qualification has been designed to prepare you for employment as a supervised assistant/apprentice or for further learning in the hairdressing and beauty therapy industries within college.

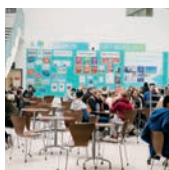
How I will learn?

Maths & English

Full-time 16-18 year olds who do not have a Grade C/Grade 4 or above in Maths and/or English, will attend weekly sessions with specialist tutors to work towards the relevant qualification(s). This is really useful to support you on your main course and is really valued by employers.
