VTCT Level 2 Diploma in Ladies Hairdressing

Why Ladies Hairdressing?

The Level 2 Diploma in Ladies Hairdressing is an internationally recognised qualification that is essential for a career in Hairdressing.

The Hairdressing profession offers exciting career prospects in a dynamic industry which can provide opportunities for employment in Local Salons, Fitness Centres, Health Clubs, Spas, Leisure Facilities and Cruise Ships throughout the world.

You will be given practical experience in Mosaic, our commercial salon, which simulates a real working environment. You may also have the opportunity to undertake work placement in the industry and visit a hairdressing and beauty exhibition.

Entry Requirements

- 4 GCSEs at grade D / Grade 3 or above or
- a Level 1 qualification in a vocationally related course with an average grade of a Merit is required.

For students aged over 19 years there are no formal requirements.

What will I learn?

The qualification comprises of the following units:

- Cutting ladies hair
- Colour & lighten hair
- Blow dry and style hair
- Shampoo, condition and treat the hair and scalp
- Set and dress hair
- Advise and consult with clients
- Health and safety and hygiene
- Promoting products and services

Plus, optional units to reflect skills and knowledge. This may include, competition work, perming and plaiting.

How will I learn?

- Produce a formative service/treatment portfolio
- Practical assessments
- External exams / internal exams

Maths & English

Full-time 16-18 year olds who do not have a Grade C/Grade 4 or above in Maths and/or English, will attend weekly sessions with specialist tutors to work towards the relevant qualification(s). This is really useful to support you on your main course and is really valued by employers.

Work Experience

As part of your programme of study you will be required to complete 37 hours of work experience. You will be supported by the college's placement officers to find you a suitable employer.





What can I do after my course?

You can progress onto VTCT Level 3 Diploma in Ladies Hairdressing. This will allow you to increase your hairdressing skills and further your career within the Hairdressing industry.

Kit & Uniform
