

ECITB CCNSG SAFETY PASSPORT RENEWAL

DURATION

1 Day

OBJECTIVE

The ECITB CCNSG Renewal Course is a one day refresher for those who already hold the CCNSG Safety Passport National Course. The Renewal course can only be taken if a delegate's current card is within the 3 month grace period: This is 3 months before, and up to 3 months after the card expiry date. Once this grace period has lapsed candidates must take the full 2 day CCNSG Safety Passport course.

WHO SHOULD ATTEND?

This course is designed for Managers, Supervisors and Operatives working within the petro-chemical, engineering and installation and maintenance sectors including contactor personnel, who need to renew an existing CCNSG Safety Passport card.

Areas Covered:

- Safe working practices and permits to work
- Safe access and egress
- Accidents and First Aid procedures
- Fire precautions and procedures
- COSHH, Manual Handling and Personal Protective Equipment
- Noise
- Excavations and working with cranes and heavy equipment

HOW IS THE COURSE ASSESSED?

Each module of the CCNSG 1 Day Safety Passport Renewal is assessed through two multiple choice question papers each consisting of 30 questions each. The examination pass mark for each paper is set at 80%.

CERTIFICATION

On successful completion of the course delegates will receive a new ECITB CCNSG Safety Passport card valid for another 3 years.
