COURSE DETAILS

The NEBOSH National Fire Safety and Risk Management Certificate provides an appropriate breadth of underpinning knowledge for non-specialists in fire safety to enable them to discharge more effectively their organisational duties or functions with respect to workplace fire safety.

The course is designed to enable holders of the National General Certificate who have passed the qualification in the last five years to complete the NEBOSH Fire Safety and Risk Management Certificate. The course therefore contains the additional units that are required to enable the student to complete the NEBOSH National Fire Safety and Risk Management Certificate.

The syllabus is divided into 2 Units and 6 elements in total:

- Unit FC 1 Fire Safety and Risk Management.
- Unit FC2 Practical Fire Risk Assessment.

WHO SHOULD ATTEND?

This accredited NEBOSH Certificate training course is for managers, supervisors, employee representatives and others. It aims to equip holders to contribute to the conduct and review of fire risk assessments and fire preventive and protective measures within most workplaces.

Course Covers

- Managing fire safety
- Principles of fire and explosion
- Causes and prevention of fire
- Fire protection in buildings
- Safety of people in the event of a fire
- Fire risk assessment

HOW WILL THE COURSE BE ASSESSED?

Each unit of the NEBOSH National Fire Safety and Risk Management Certificate is assessed separately. FC1 is assessed by a two hour written examination. Unit FC2 is assessed by a practical fire risk assessment in the workplace.
