EAL LEVEL 3 AWARD IN PERIODIC INSPECTION, TESTING AND CERTIFICATION OF ELECTRICAL INSTALLATIONS

DURATION

5 Days

OBJECTIVE

This award is for understanding the theory and practice of periodic inspection, testing and condition reporting, of both single and three phase electrical installations. The qualification follows BS 7671 and the industry recognised IET Guidance Note 3, as well as the Electrical Safety Council's Best Practice Guidelines.

The following areas are covered:

- Safe Isolation
- Condition Reporting Requirements
- Periodic Inspection
- Testing Interpreting Test Results and Certification

WHO SHOULD ATTEND?

Electricians who wish to carry out the periodic inspection and testing of electrical installations and issue electrical installation condition reports or those who wish to acquire new knowledge and skills.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Students must have successfully completed the IEE Wiring Regulations - 17th Edition (BS 7671:2008). This qualification is for qualified electricians who actively engage in inspection and testing.

HOW IS THE COURSE ASSESSED?

The assessment involves both online examination and practical assessments.
